**THE ORIENTEERING EVENT ITSELF CARRIES A SEPARATE MAP FEE OF \$4 PER ENTRY. IN ORIENTEERING
YOUR ‘ENTRY’ IS THE GROUP THAT HIKES TOGETHER. YOU MAY ENTER INDIVIDUALLY OR AS A GROUP
OF AS MANY AS 4.**

Notes: Instructors will be on-site to explain how the game works, but they do not accompany you on the course. Dress for the weather. We go rain or shine! Bring plenty of water to drink while you hike. No pre-registration required. Just show up and have fun. There is no mass start at orienteering events; instead Entries are assigned a Start time on-site and are started at 2 minute intervals on each of the three courses offered, all within the 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. window. There will be a 2-hour time limit at this event for each course, meaning all Entries must finish their hike and return to registration area within 2 hours of their Start time. The event ends at 3:00 p.m. After your hike you’ll be able to enjoy the grounds, buildings and museum at the beautiful Florida Agricultural Museum.
