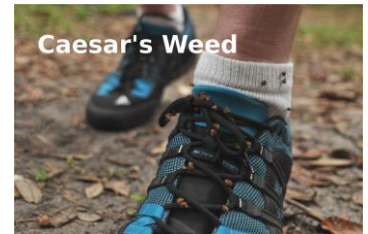

3 EASY STEPS TO

STOP INVASIVES IN YOUR TRACKS

Stay on trails

- In the course of some recreational activities you may be traveling off trail. Be aware you have a greater impact on the environment and are at increased risk of spreading seeds.

Avoid Infestations

- Take a few moments to become familiar with some of the most common local weeds and how their seeds travel.

Come Clean / Leave Clean

- Clean gear and clothing before entering and before leaving a recreation site.
- Be sure to dispose of seeds responsibly, don't throw them on the trail side or out a car window.
- Some seeds are tiny and can travel in mud on sneakers and bike tires.
