THE TRAINING

A variety of practical exercises will be used to build and enhance orienteering skills. See enclosed sample of training exercises. Different training areas will be established in order to provide familiarization and use of the widest range of skill and terrain possible. Training will be conducted in a round robin fashion. Cadets will move from training area to training area, where they will be instructed on how to complete the designated training site. Cadets should be trained in basic orienteering prior to attendance (See, FLO website tutorials). The focus of the camp is practical application.

* Schools need to bring their own compasses, whistles and flashlights

* All maps will be provided

***** An appropriately registered (Meets your school requirements) adult Male/Female Chaperone must accompany and remain with your cadets at all times when not on the training or competition courses *****

REGISTRATION

Early registration is before 1 Sep 19. Deadline for camp registration is 9 Sept 2019. Early registration fees are \$50 per cadet and \$60 per cadet AFTER 1 Sept 2019. FIRST COME 1ST SERVED! The training day only fee is \$25 per cadet prior to 1 Sep and \$30 after.

For those competing in Sunday's competition only, Pre-registration prior to 1 Sep the fee is \$11 individual. After 1 Sep. the fee is \$15 per cadet.

** The Competition and training are included in camp fee **

CAMP SET UP

- Each school will be required to bring their own camping gear, ie. Tents and sleeping bags etc. Wood for campfires is not provided and must be brought with you as no cutting or gathering in camp is allowed.
- Male and female head and shower facilities are available.

- Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided on Saturday. Breakfast only on Sunday. Included for Camp attendees.
- Meals for Friday dinner and Sunday lunch can be purchased separately.
- Meals are not included for training only or competition only. They can be preordered if desired
